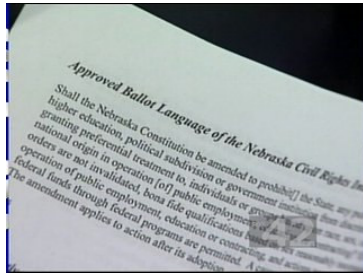




Forum Aims to Inform on Impact of Affirmative Action Ban
